

# Read2Succeed

© A structured programme to develop & raise reading skills, self confidence and self esteem in pupils with special educational needs in Years 4-6

Read2Succeed has been researched and developed by Heather Stack, Director, Learning Services (SEN) Ltd, over the past 20 months. It is now in its final trial phase and is supporting pupils from Years 4 – 6 in primary schools in Warwickshire & Oxfordshire. Results from the third trial period will be available in January 2007 and progress of the third round of trials can be followed now on the website [www.learning-services.org.uk](http://www.learning-services.org.uk).

**Results from the initial trial periods have exceeded expectations, showing increases in reading ages of up to 19 months and reading comprehension of up to 20 months in a 14 week period.**

The programme is designed to run through the Autumn and Spring terms with a time commitment of just 2 x 30 minute sessions weekly of 1 – 1 support for each child on the programme. There is a requirement for training and support from a Learning Services' consultant for data collection, including standardized reading assessments, and charting baselines of each pupil. Final results are collated through a range of objective, quantifiable data, including reassessment on the Neale Analysis of Reading Ability, and also through pupil observations, reading behaviours, levels of reading scheme books and class teacher and support staff comments.

### **From the first two trial periods, value added benefits have included -**

- Increased self confidence and self esteem
- Significant increase in motivation and eagerness to read
- Increased achievements in maths
- Greater independence in learning in the classroom across the curriculum.
- Improved relations and communications between home and school
- Training and development opportunities for teaching and support staff.
- Achievements above expectations at Key Stage 2 SATs
